(A) "Political party" means any group of voters that at the last preceding general election polled for its candidate for Governor in the state or nominees for presidential electors at least one ~~three~~ percent (3 ~~1~~%) of the entire vote cast for the office.

(B) A group of electors shall not assume a name or designation that is so similar in the opinion of the Secretary of State to that of an existing political party as to confuse or mislead the voters at an election.

(C) When any political party fails to obtain ~~three~~ one percent (3 ~~1~~%) of the total votes cast at an election for the office of Governor or nominees for presidential electors, it shall cease to be a political party;

Section 3. If any provision of this act is found to be invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This act shall take effect upon passage.
