3. The term "party" means any political organization which, excluding blank and void ballots, at the last preceding election for governor received, at least ~~two~~ one percent of the total votes cast for its candidate for governor, or ~~one hundred~~ thirty thousand votes, whichever is ~~greater~~ less, in the year in which a governor is elected and at least two percent of the total votes cast for its candidate for president, or one hundred thirty thousand votes, whichever is greater, in a year when a President is elected.

Section 3. If any provision of this act is found to be invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This act shall take effect upon passage.
