Tennessee Annotated Code § 2-1-104

(23) “Recognized minor party” means any group or association that has successfully petitioned by filing with the coordinator of elections a petition which shall conform to requirements established by the coordinator of elections, but which must at a minimum bear the signatures of registered voters equal to at least ~~two and one-half percent (2.5%)~~ one percent (1%) of the total number of votes cast for gubernatorial candidates in the most recent election of governor, or 10,000 signatures from registered voters, whichever is less, and on each page of the petition, state its purpose, state its name, and contain the names of registered voters from a single county;

Section 3. If any provision of this act is found to be invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This act shall take effect upon passage.
