Required number of signatures

Sec. 3. (a) A petition of nomination must be signed by the number of voters equal to ~~two~~ one percent (~~2%~~) (1%) of the total vote cast at the last election for secretary of state in the election district that the candidate seeks to represent or 10,000 signatures, whichever is less.

(b) In determining the number of signatures required under this section, any fraction in excess of a whole number must be disregarded.

(c) If an election district is included entirely within one (1) precinct, and does not include the entire precinct, the petition of nomination must be signed by at least five (5) voters of the election district.

Section 3. If any provision of this act is found to be invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This act shall take effect upon passage.
