

Section 1: An Act to Establish Signature Thresholds for Independent Candidates to Earn Ballot Access

Section 2: Amendments to Arizona Revised Code 7-7-103 (B)

(B) If the person is a candidate for state office or for United States Senator in which a statewide race is required, the person shall file petitions signed by not less than ~~three~~ one percent (~~3~~1%) of the qualified electors of the state or which contain five ~~ten~~ thousand (~~10,000~~ 5,000) signatures of qualified electors, whichever is the lesser.

Section 3. If any provision of this act is found to be invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This act shall take effect upon passage.
